

## **VISITATION**

Visitation is intended to provide patients and loved ones the opportunity to learn and grow together in the recovery process.

Upon your first Saturday visit or any new adult visitor (spouse, Parent, grandparent, guardian) you will be required to watch a 1 hour video presentation. This will then be followed by a 30 min visitation. Once the video has been completed your following Saturday visits will consist of a one hour visit.

Saturdays between 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM. Children  
Sundays between 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM Family/ Adult

Residents are allowed a maximum of three (3) visitors on the family day unless prior approval. (NO PETS PLEASE)

Visitations must be scheduled the Wednesday prior to the weekend visit. If the visitor has not been previously approved and is not on the check in list for the weekend visit, they will have to reschedule for the following visitation date. Visits are subject to approval by the resident's primary counselor or clinical director.

**OUTSIDE FOOD, OPEN BEVERAGE CONTAINERS, READING MATERIAL, MEDICATIONS, WEAPONS, TECHNOLOGICAL (INCLUDING CELLPHONES) DEVICES ARE NOT TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE VISITATION.** These rules exist across the board for all visitors. NBRC reserves the right to inspect any and all packages that arrive from outside the facility. If approved, your resident will receive these items later in the day.

Upon arrival, **VISITORS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN UPON ENTERING THE FACILITY. NBRC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INSPECT BAGS/ PURSES BEING BROUGHT INTO THE PREMISIS.**

**PLEASE LEAVE CELL PHONES AND CAMERAS IN YOUR VEHICLE OR CHECK THEM AT THE FRONT DESK.**

Residents may receive visitors in the reception area. Visitors **ARE NOT ALLOWED IN PATIENT BEDROOMS.**

All visitors are required to be alcohol and drug free while on the property. Any visitor found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return. Special accommodations can be made through the primary counselor or Clinical Director for AA and NA Sponsor or Religious Leader visitation outside of normal visitation hours.
